



All Quincy University teacher licensure programs, administrative licensure programs, and school counselor licensure programs are fully accredited by the Illinois State Board of Education. Quincy University has approved programs in Quincy in the following areas leading to teacher licensure:

- K-9 Elementary (Type 03 certificate)
- 6-12 Secondary (Type 09 certificate)
  - Biology
  - History
  - English
  - Mathematics
- K-12 Special (Type 10 certificate)
  - Special Education
  - Music
  - Physical Education

In addition, Quincy University is approved for a School Counseling program leading to a Type 73 certificate and for school administration leading to a Type 75 certificate. The Type 75 preparation program is being phased out and no new students will be accepted.
